- Click "Login"

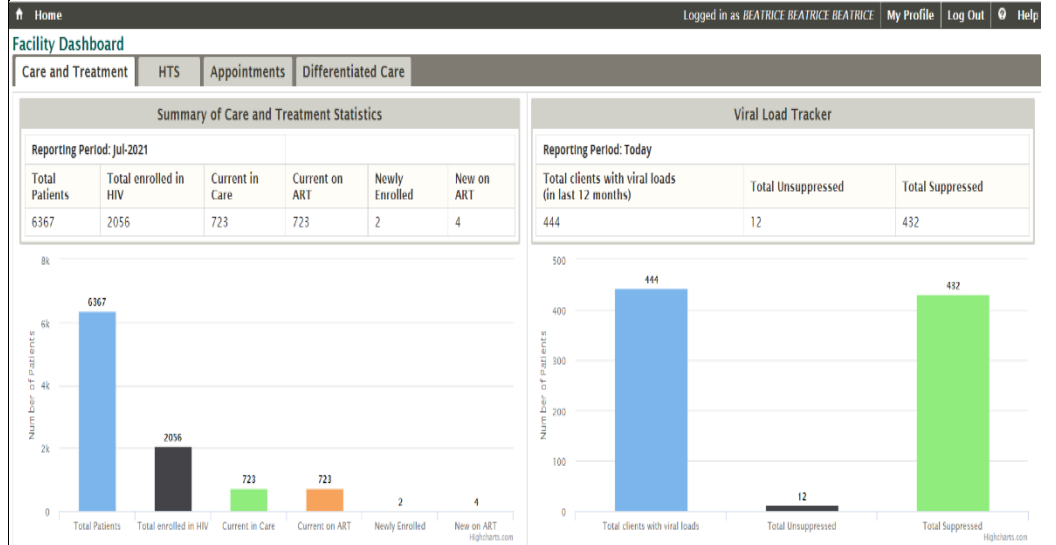


KenyaEMR Landing Page
