









Alternatively, you can click the patient's name from the active visits to access patient summary dashboard.

The patient dashboard contains a left navigation bar, horizontal bar, midget menu, and Vitals and Anthropometrics section.









### **Horizontal Navigation Bar.**

It contains a hamburger menu, KenyaEMR logo, client name, 2.x chart icon, and a check in/ check out button.

Hamburger menu: If clicked, will load the left navigation bar when clicked. KenyaEMR logo: If clicked, will load the

home page.


Client Name: Shows patient name. 2.x Chart button: If clicked, will navigate back to KenyaEMR 2.x


Check in/ check out button is used to check in or check out the client.

Lets go throough each of these one by one.













**Vitals & Anthropometrics:** When clicked, it shows the previous vitals and anthropometrics captured as illustrated.



#### Care panel:


It contains Health programs that a client is eligible for, summary of the health programs, and a print summary.



















Displays all clinical encounters and visit summaries.

Visit summaries button








**Allergies**: Displays all recorded allergies that a client has and also allows clinicians to add new allergies.















# **Family history:** Shows a list of existing clients wo are related to the clients.










#### Midget menu
