

Tasks:	Enroll and manage an infant into the Child Services in the MCH program
Objective:	Record MCH Child enrolment data and record care received by HIV exposed infants and facilitate follow up throughout a child's life in the HEI program
Required Materials:	Username, password, computer with KenyaEMR 3.x ver 18.7.2 and above, patient name, ID, and/or age
Description:	KenyaEMR supports a comprehensive MCH module that supports documentation, tracking and reporting of both mother and Child enrolled in MCH program. This manual outlines how to enroll HEI into MCH – Child program, Document CWC Follow up information, Immunization details and the HEI outcomes.
Who:	Doctor, Clinical Officer, Nurse, Health records officer or data clerk

Step 1: Login to KenyaEMR.

Enter the application server URL system. “[*ServerIpAddress:8080/openmrs/spa*]” and click on the load button or Enter key from the keyboard. On successful loading, you should be navigated to the system login page.

Authenticate entry by providing username on the field and click “*Continue*” Upon successful login, you shall be navigated to the password page.


Step 2: Access the homepage.

To access MCH – child Services Module - Find or Create a patient.

If the client **doesn't exist** in the system, click on the **Add patient** icon on the top right of the page to register them in the system.

This will load the patient registration form as shown. Complete the registration and upon saving it will display the patient home page.

Step 3: Create a relationship (If not existing)

It is important to pair the child with the mother or a guardian to achieve paired care provision.

To do this, follow the steps below:


Step 1: On the registration form, click 'Add Relationship'.

Step 2: Specify the mother / guardian that you intend to pair with this child by searching under **Related Person** as shown. To search, enter any part of the person's name and scan through the list of available persons to identify the correct person. Click on the correct name.


Step 3: Under **Relationship to patient**, select Parent or Guardian (whichever applies)

Step 4: Proceed with registration and register patient.

If the relationship already exists, skip this process, and proceed to enroll the child in MCH-Child service as shown below.

Step 8: Recording Child Immunization Details

Child immunization details can be recorded as they happen. The same form will be updated whenever new vaccinations is administered.

To access the form, search for the child using the search icon at the top.

- Click and open the child's profile.
- Check in the child for the visit. Locate immunizations as in the left panel as highlighted.

On the Immunization form, Specify the Vaccination date / time.


Locate the vaccine that is being administered today. (If retrospective, record all the vaccinations and specify respective date of administration).

- Specify the Lot number and the expiry date.
- Specify the dosage and units.
- Set the date given and the date of the next visit.
- Under Vitamin A Sections, Specify the vitamins given and the date.

If fully immunized, set the date the child is given the last vaccine.

Click Save to submit.

Please Note: This form is reused whenever a vaccine or vitamin A Capsules are given throughout the child's life under HEI program.





Step 9: Recording the Child HEI outcomes.

According to the PMTCT guideline, the child should be monitored under HEI program for a period of 18 months after which they exit the program.

On exit, you need to record the child's outcome as follows.

- Search for the child using the search icon.
- Check in the child for the visit and record any relevant information for the day's encounter (i.e., CWC follow up, immunization etc.)
- Click clinical forms as highlighted (1), then search for the Child HEI outcomes as highlighted (2) and click on the form. This will open the HEI exit form shown in the next page.





Step 10: Exit the child from MCH-Child services.

This step allows a user to discontinue a child from MCH-Child services.

- While on the client profile, click on the care panel as highlighted.
- Then click on the 'Panel summary' as shown.
- Under the enrollment history, at the far right click on the action icon highlighted to see the 'Discontinue' button.
- On the form, specify the discontinuation date.
- Specify reason for discontinuation (Select from a list)
- Click 'Save and close' to submit.

Please note: This action is performed as the last operation since it completely exits the child from the CWC service and therefore disallows any other CWC related encounter to be captured for this child.






