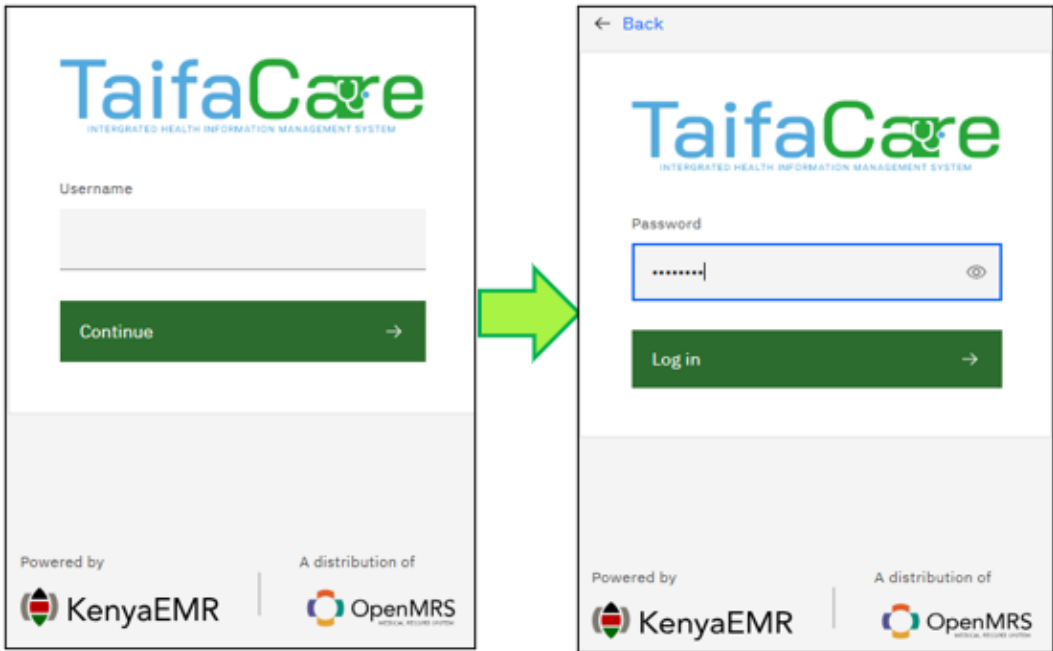


SOP: TaifaCare Enhanced Adherence Screening

Assess for possible barriers to adherence - Cognitive

1. (HIV and ART Knowledge) Assess patient's knowledge about HIV and ART; correct any misconceptions

Assess for possible barriers to adherence - Behavioural

1. Let the patient explain how they take their drugs, and at what time and how they store them

2. How does treatment fit the patient daily routines? What reminder tools are used?
