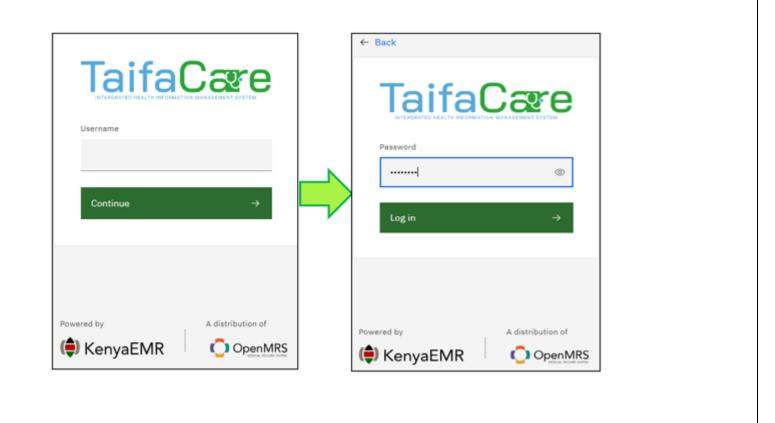






Step 1 Login to TaifaCare

- Load the
 TaifaCare on
 your Browser
 using the right
 URL for the
 machine.
- Contact System admin at the facility for correct URL.
- On successful loading in, authenticate entry by proving username and password on the fields, then click "Login" button



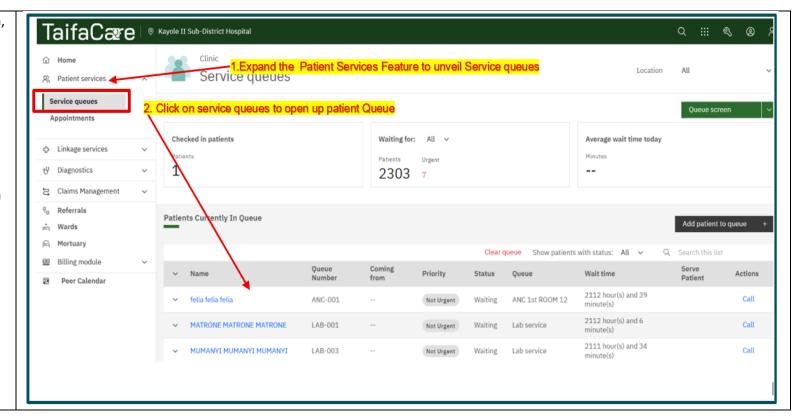






Upon successful login, the home page will load with the active list of clients visiting the facility "today".

Expand the Patient Services Menu to unveil the "Service Queues" menu which lists the patient in queue.







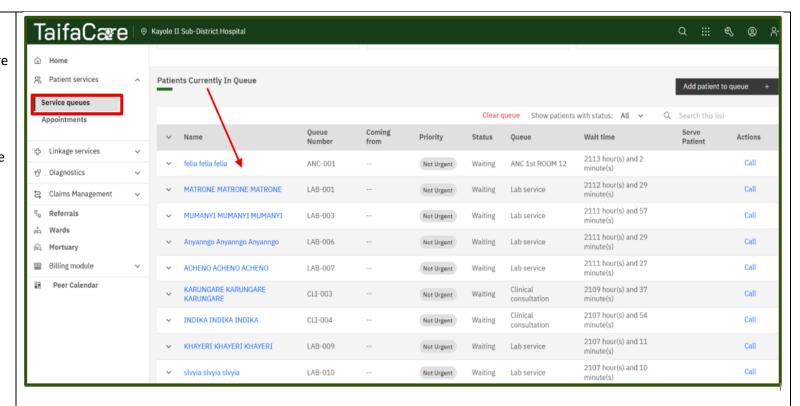


TaifaCare Service Queues Page

Once you click on the service queues, locate the name of the patient under the patient in queues as shown.

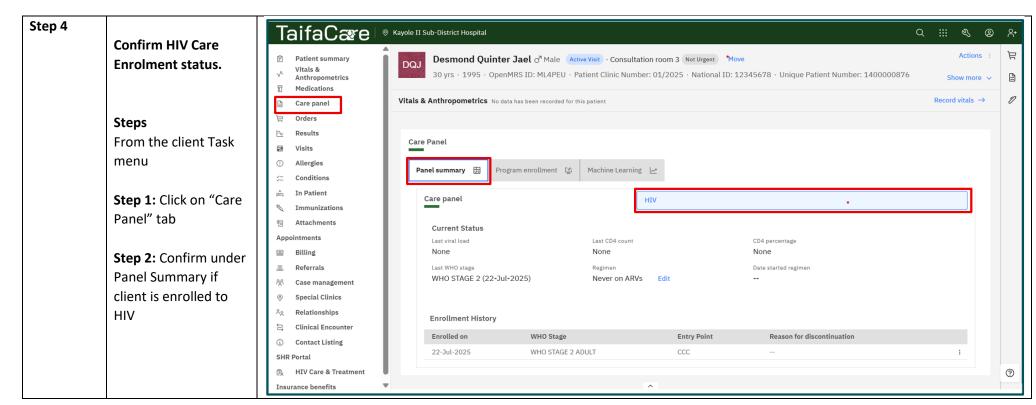
Click on the 'Call button' which will take you to the patient profile.









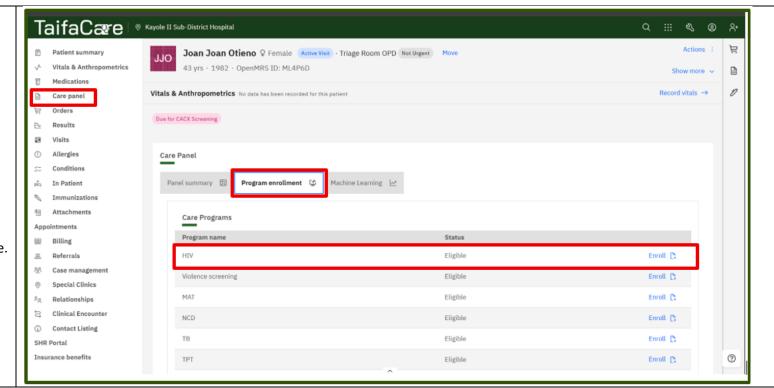








HIV Care Enrolment
While on the care
panel, click on
'Program enrolment'
as shown to access

Click on "Enroll" to

Eligible for the service.



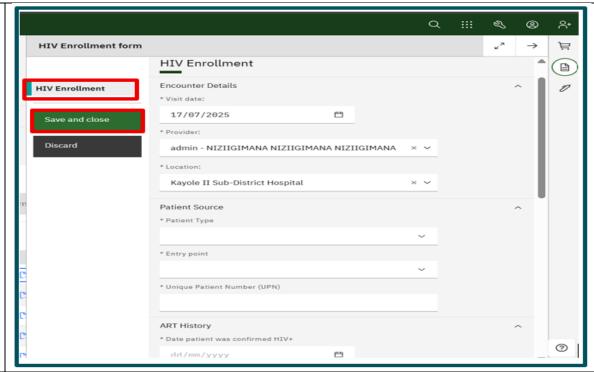






Step 6 HIV Care Enrolment Cont.....

- Once you click on 'enroll', the 'HIV Enrolment form will open as shown.
- Click "Save and Close" after filling in all the necessary fields in the enrolment form.

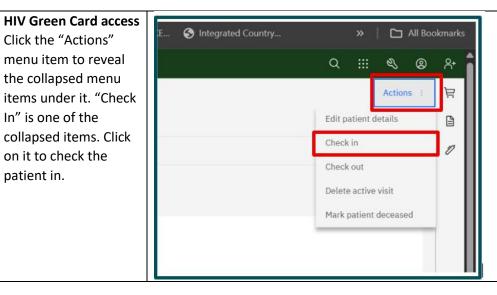








Click the "Actions" menu item to reveal the collapsed menu items under it. "Check In" is one of the collapsed items. Click on it to check the patient in.

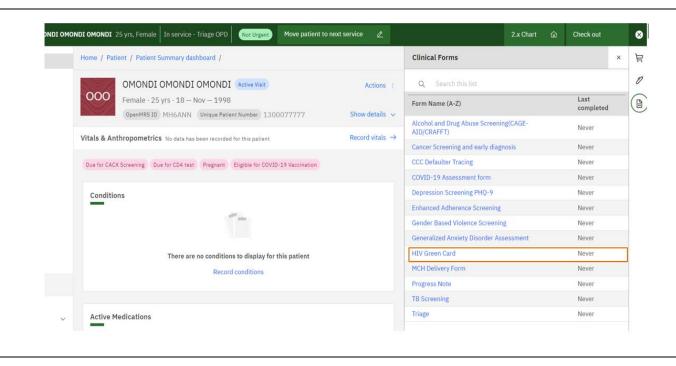








After checking in the HIV Green card is now available under the suite of Clinical form. Click on it to open the form.





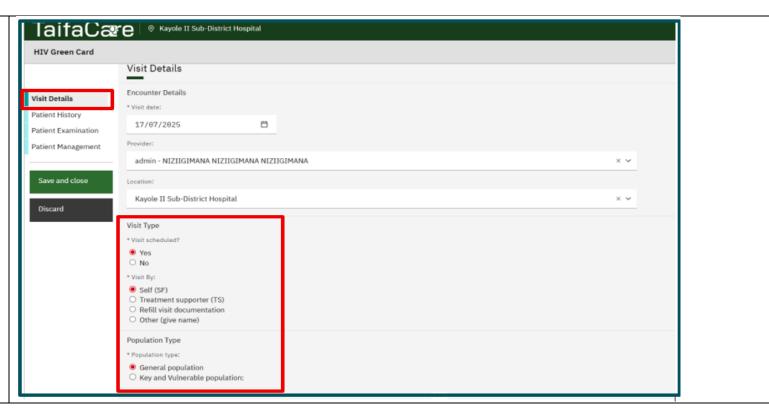




The HIV Green card is divided into 4 tabs as Highlighted below **Visit Details Tab:**

Documents provide information about the nature of visit and the client typology. Fill all the questions, then click Next at the bottom of the page as highlighted.

NB: For all the questions with an asterisk means they are mandatory.

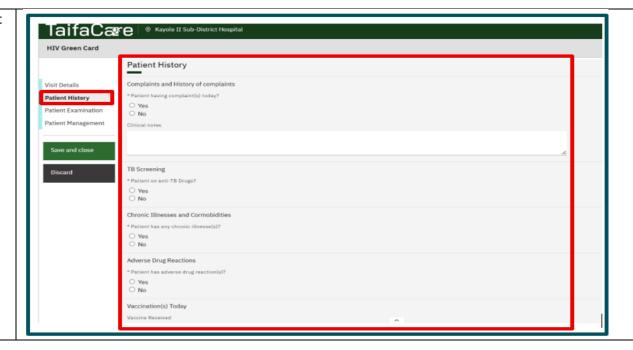








Patient History that collects the patients historical medical history that includes historical TB and IPT interventions. TB Screening



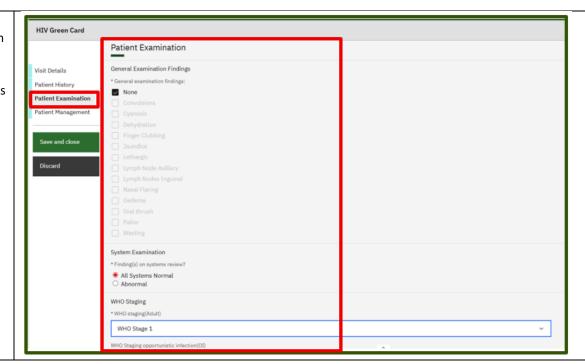






Patient Examination

that collects information on clients General, and systems review examination. The clients WHO status and diagnosis based on the ICD 11 coding is documented here. Record the review of body systems reviewed and the findings. Once done with examination, click on 'Next' at the bottom of the page to move to 'Patient Management'.





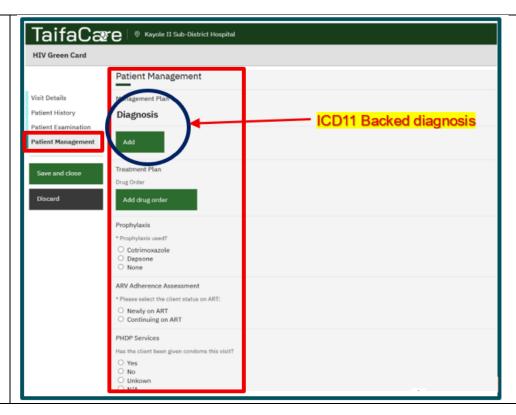




ICD 11 Coding backed diagnosis illustrated.

Click on 'Add' button under Diagnosis to add patient's diagnosis. Search by typing at most more than 2 characters, suggestions will appear. Pick the correct one.

NB: You can add more than one diagnosis by clicking 'Add'.

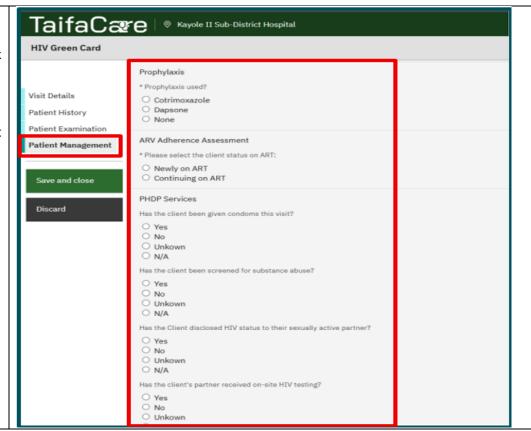








Patient Management collects information on prognosis and work up plan that has been recommended for the client. The client's adherence assessment is also assessed at this point using Morisky. Complete the rest of the sections appropriately.









Patient Management cont....

Record client's establishment status then gives the next return visit date.
Save and Close Green card to validate data captured and to bring the encounter to a close.

Discard if you don't

Discard if you don't want to save the changes. Move patient to next service to end Clinical encounter.
