











Upon successful logging in, you'll be landed onto Taifa Care's home page. Click on the search icon to search for the patient.



Type the name or the id number of the patient and click the name to select










Alternatively, you can click the patient's name from the active visits to access patient summary dashboard.










Patient summary dashboard.

1. Patient Details


- These include patient identifiers, i.e. the name, clinic number, gender, whether the client has an active visit or not, etc.

2. Vitals & Anthropometrics

- This displays the temperature, weight, height, BMI, blood pressure, heart rate, respiratory rate - Click Record Vitals on
- the right hand side to update new measurements. This loads the Triage form

3. Action

- This contains; the Check in and Check Out, delete active visit, mark patient as deceased, and edit patient details









Midget menu

The midget menu is located on the right-hand side of the screen. It contains clinical forms, order basket, and visit notes




Left Navigaton Bar:

When clicked, it shows the previous vitals and anthropometrics captured as illustrated










2. Medications

- When the add button is clicked, it open and order basket










3. care Panel:

This contains summary of the health programs the patient is elegible for and Machine Learning Predictions for the patient.










4. Orders

 Displays all the orders done for the patient.










5. **Results**

 This section displays all the results for orders test ordered for the patient










6. Visits

- This shows all recorded patient visits,including visit type,date, diagnoses, and details of clinical encounters during those visits










7. Allergies:

allergies.










8. Conditions

 Displays all recorded conditions that the patient has and also allows clinician to add new condition










9. **In Patient**

 This screen displays all the encounters for an inpatient client










10. Immunizations:

- This allows you to add new immunization administered and also view past immunizations administered.










11. Attachments

- This contains relevant attachments such as X-rays and pictures. It has a link to add more attachments










12. Appointments

- This screen shows the Appointments section










13. Billing history:


- Based on your user roles, this screen shows the history of paid, waivered, and unpaid services of a client. Also allows a clinician to record additional billing details.
